



Leslie Leon Williamson

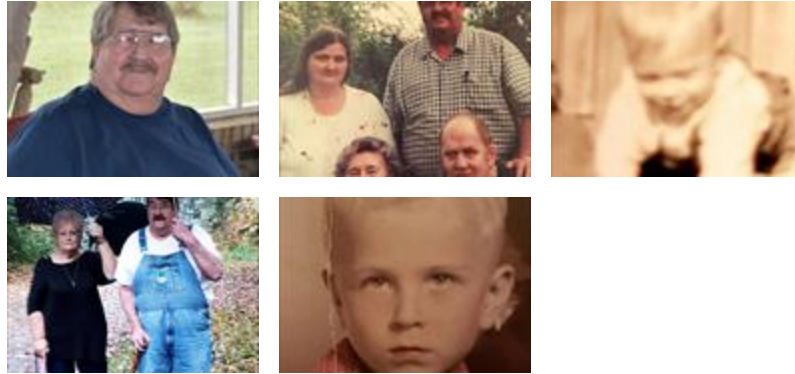
June 1, 1947 - January 20, 2022

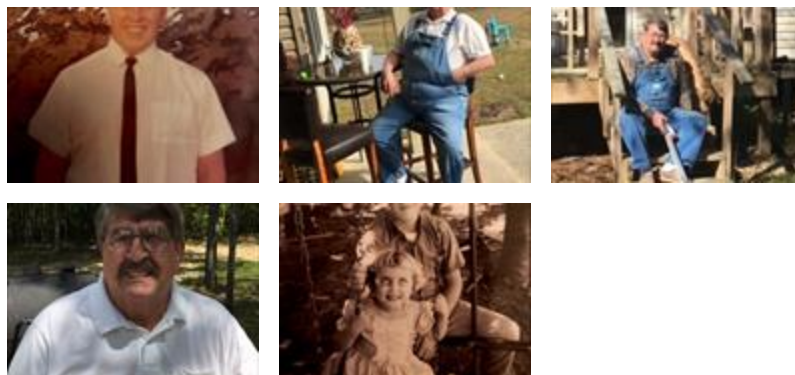
