

Mary Elizabeth Creel Harrell

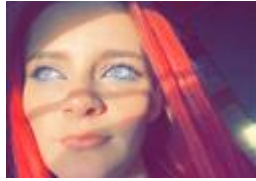
August 9, 1960 - September 7, 2021
