Thomas Grady Jordan, 64, of Hattiesburg, MS, joined Our Father in Heaven on Saturday, February 22, 2020. He passed away peacefully, after a very long and brave battle with chronic lung disease.

He enjoyed reading his Bible and devotionals daily, and listening to sermons and hymns (as well as singing them, right up until his final days). During his final years, especially, Tommy drew strength in his faith from his strong Christian upbringing, and through encouragement from at least two true angels on earth!

Tommy grew up and went to school in Petal, MS. He then worked as a heavy equipment operator, primarily at Hattiesburg Hot Mix, for several years. Later, he earned his computer science degree from the University of Southern Mississippi, and became a software test engineer for Intergraph Corporation in Huntsville, Alabama.
